Railway line


Harappa - (Present day Pakistan)

High quality bricks

80 yrs later -- archaeologists - one of the
oldest city

4700 years ago.

What was special about these cities.



Special cities → Ex:

- 1) Mohenjodaro - Great Bath - water tight - layer of natural tar
- 2) Kalibangan & Lothal → fire Altars

Houses, drains & streets

Houses : one or two storey

rooms around courtyard

separate bathing area

wells

Drains : covered

laid out in straight lines

gentle slope for water to flow

smaller drains led to larger ones

inspection holes at regular intervals.

Streets : - ~~horizontal &~~ perpendicular

to each other. [Cross / Main Roads.]

Life in the city

Rulers : planned the city

got precious stones, gems from distant land.

Scribes : ppl who knew how to write
prepared seals.

Crafts persons : made things @ homes or special workshops

* Terracotta toys were found.


New crafts in the city:

Things made of

Beads, weights and blades found.

Seals of stone

Spindle whorls → made of terracotta & Faience.

Faience

→ artificially produced

- gum used to shape sand or powdered quartz into an object.

- used to make beads, bangles, earrings.

In search of raw materials.

Copper : from present day Rajasthan and Oman (West Asia)

Bronze : Tin mixed with copper.
 ↳ from Afghanistan.

Gold : Karnataka

Precious stones : Gujarat, Iran & Afghanistan.

Food for people in the cities.

Country side people

- Grew crops : wheat, barley, rice, linseed, pulses, peas, sesame & mustard.

- reared animals : cattle, sheep, goat & buffalo.

↓
 - Supplied food to crafts person, scribes & rulers.

- Since no heavy rainfall - irrigation must be used.

A closer look - Harappan towns in Gujarat.

Dholavira - [Rann of Kutch].

↳ divided into 3 parts

{ normally cities divided
into two parts
[citadel ↗ lower town] }

→ Large letters of Harappan Script } writing
carved of white stone & usually
inlaid in wood. found on
small objects as seals

Lothal - [on tributary of Sabarmati,
Gulf of Khambat].

- Huge tank found - may have been dockyard
- situated near area where semi-precious stones were found.
- remains of workshop of making beads found.

* Seals & sealings

Seals & sealings used to ensure goods arrived safely.

The mystery of the end.

Around 3900 years ago things started changing.

Reasons could be:

- Deforestation // grazing
 used as fuel.
- Rivers drying up, or
- Some areas were destroyed by floods
- Rulers lost control

New cities emerged 1400 years later.
